Scholarships Change Lives for T.C. Williams Graduates

- Since 1986, we have awarded \$14.5 MILLION IN SCHOLARSHIPS.
- We have sent More than 4,600 Alexandria Students TO COLLEGE.
- Our Financial-Need based scholarships average \$3,000/year. Our Largest scholarship is \$10,000/year!
- 93¢ of every \$1 we receive goes <u>directly</u> to scholarships.
- Almost HALF of our 2018 Recipients will be the FIRST in their family to attend college.
- Our Financial need-based scholarships are eligible for <u>renewal through</u> <u>all four years of college</u>, **making college graduation a reality.**
- In 2018, SFA received its HIGHEST number of scholarship applications in program history a 26% increase from 2017-2018. The need is great.
